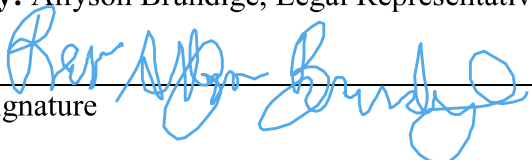

This is to certify that I have taken or agree to take the action requested below to resolve the violations of child care regulations identified in the draft Statement of Charges and discussed during the Compliance Meeting on December 16, 2021.

I also understand and agree that if the Agency determines that the violations of child care regulations identified in the draft Statement of Charges reoccur in the future, the violations will no longer be considered resolved by this Plan and the Agency may bring disciplinary action based upon the violations identified in the draft Statement of Charges. This Negotiated Corrective Action Plan (NCAP) will be effective upon signature.

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1. The Operator shall, within two months from the effective date of this Negotiated Corrective Action Plan, require that all administrators and staff successfully complete the Child Care Education Institute training on Safety in the Infant/Toddler Classroom. The training is available at <https://www.cceionline.com/course/safety-in-the-infant-toddler-classroom/>. The Operator shall ensure that all new staff receive this training prior to their assuming caregiving responsibilities. This training may count toward staff's professional development hours. The Operator shall maintain documentation that administrators and staff successfully completed such training on file at the Facility for Agency review.
 2. The Operator shall ensure Initial Director Technical Assistance training from the Agency is completed within two months from the effective date of this Negotiated Corrective Action Plan. The Operator shall maintain on site for Agency review appropriate documentation of completion of such technical assistance.
 3. The Operator attests, by way of signature below, that the Director and Allyson Brundige have read the Regulations pertaining to Child Care Centers (available online at <https://www.ctoec.org/licensing/statutes-and-regulations>) and have been advised that the Office of Early Childhood Licensing Division helpdesk is available for questions regarding the application and/or interpretation of the Regulations.
