


• Reviewed safe transportation when transporting children. Witnessed provider arrive in vehicle with all three children. Provider has two boosters and one carseat.


~~#65~~⁴⁴ Did not observed individual hand drying mechanism in bathroom. Children used same cotton towel after each wash.

#99 Observed administration of medication training expired on 1/21/2022.


