Observations/Corrections needed:

(S) 19a-79-10(g)(4) Under three endorsement, sleep arrangements - Operator failed to place child in an approved crib for rest when it was observed that a 6 month old child was sleeping on a boppy pillow on the floor with a blanket over him, partially covering his face.

(S) 19a-79-7a<sup>(e)</sup>(11) Physical plant, garbage maintained - operator failed to maintain garbage when <sup>used</sup> paper towels observed on carpet with toddlers, cheerias were observed in a crib (not being used at the time) and crib sheet was stained. A crushed juice box was observed on the floor

(S) 19a-79-7a(c)(2) Physical plant, grounds kept clean - Operator failed to maintain clean carpets when two carpets in a toddler room were observed to have small scraps/refuse on them. Toys/blocks observed on bathroom floor and on diaper changing table.

Discussed having conversations w/ parents in a private location  
Discussed that there is evidence that the infant room was out of ratio - This had been cited on previous complaint and will not be cited again, as the program addressed the staffing shortage at that time.
