CONSENT ORDER

IN THE MATTER OF:

WHEREAS, Tondra A. Jenkins of Hartford, Connecticut ("Licensee"), has been issued license # 52032 to operate a Family Child Care Home located at 92 Vine Street, #3A Hartford, CT by the Connecticut Office of Early Childhood ("Agency") pursuant to § 19a-87b of the General Statutes of Connecticut ("Statutes");

WHEREAS, the Department of Children and Families ("DCF") made a finding substantiating abuse and/or neglect by a member of the Licensee's household and such finding is included on the DCF child abuse or neglect registry;

WHEREAS, the Agency and the Licensee wish to ensure and protect the safety and health of the children enrolled in the family child care home.

NOW THEREFORE, the parties hereby stipulate to the following:

1. The Licensee agrees that she is responsible for the supervision of the children at all times, indoors, outdoors, and on excursions, in accordance with § 19a-87b-10 (i) of the Regulations.
2. The Licensee agrees that no persons may act as staff in the family child care home until they have been approved as staff by the Agency.
3. The Licensee agrees that she must notify the Agency in writing of any change in circumstances, which alter or affect the provision of family child care services, including but not limited to criminal convictions or DCF investigations of the provider, staff, and/or household members, and that such notification shall be given no later than five working days from the date of the change in circumstances, in accordance with § 19a-87b-6 (j) of the Regulations.
4. This Consent Order shall become effective on the day it is signed by a representative of the Office of Early Childhood.
5. This Consent Order shall remain in effect until such time as the parties mutually agree, in writing, to amend, void, or otherwise supersede this Consent Order.
6. The Licensee agrees that this Consent Order is a public document and shall be reported on OEC's website and in accordance with state and federal law and regulations, and consistent with Office of Early Childhood policy.

7. The Licensee understands that this Consent Order may be considered as evidence of the in any subsequent proceeding or determination before the Agency in which the Licensee's compliance with this same Consent Order is at issue.
8. The Licensee understands any deviation from the terms of this Consent Order without prior written approval by the Agency shall constitute grounds for the Agency to take action against the license.
9. The Licensee understands that this Consent Order and terms set forth herein are not subject to reconsideration, collateral attack, or judicial review under any form or in any forum, including any right of review under Chapters 54, the Uniform Administrative Procedure Act, and 368a of the Connecticut General Statutes, or Regulations of the State of Connecticut that exist at the time the agreement is executed or may become available in the future, provided that this stipulation shall not deprive the Applicant of any other rights that it may have under the laws of the State of Connecticut or of the United States.
10. The Licensee waives the right to challenge the imposition of this Consent Order.
11. The Licensee has had the opportunity to consult with an attorney prior to signing this document.
12. This Consent Order embodies the entire agreement of the parties with respect to this matter. All previous communications or agreements regarding the subject matter of this Consent Order, whether oral or written, between the parties are superseded unless expressly incorporated herein or made a part hereof.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the parties hereto, which have caused this Order to be executed by their respective officers and officials, declare the execution of this Consent Order to be their free act and deed.
