


#73 Compliance was observed during today's follow-up visit; provider is no longer using the additional mattress in the pack n play. Provider stated she will only use crib for infant sleep. Crib manufactured in 2016 that she is utilizing now instead. In addition: a copy of regulations in Spanish was given to the provider; regulations pertaining to Safe Sleep and Crib Safety were specifically highlighted for provider to use as a reference and read verbatim by specialist during today's visit. Provider was also advised that if there is something she does not understand during an inspection, it is her responsibility to inform the specialist and obtain clarification. Follow-up conducted fully in Spanish including discussions documented on inspection form today.

#35 Compliance was also observed for carbon monoxide detector. It has been installed and is operational.
