Temperature: it was discussed that the temperature must never fall below 65 degrees in the basement where care is given. Two electric baseboard heaters with covers were purchased to correct the temperature of the room where children will be. It was discussed that today the heaters feel cool to the touch. If they get hot to the touch a barrier must be utilized to avoid posing a harm or hazard to the children. New kitchenette was observed and inspected. All cabinets are locked and sharps are stored away. Visitors may now use the side entrance of the home entering directly to the basement level. A door bell is available. Corrective action plan was collected at visit. Applicant sent it via email to specialist.
