#24 - The kitchen cabinets containing various cleaners/prescription medications were observed to now have a lock on the doors making the items inaccessible to children. The cabinet doors in the bathroom containing various cleaners/haircare products were also observed to now have a lock on them making the items inaccessible to children.
#31 - An eye hook latch was observed to have been installed on the door leading directly to the basement stairs.
#39 - Specialist observed the wooden post with the exposed nail sticking out of the fence in the backyard play area has been removed.
#40 - Specialist observed a self-closing/self-locking lock was installed on the fence in the backyard play area making the inground pool area inaccessible to the children.
#66 - The applicant has created her flexible and balanced written schedule and it is visible in the daycare area.
