Parent was made aware of the fever when the child was picked up from the program. Per director, child was sluggish and seemingly not feeling well. Program was not in compliance with this regulation.

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Failed to implement policies, plans and procedures pertaining to communication with the parents, when staff did not appropriately notify/contact the parent of a child who was running a fever while at the program. Parent was made aware of child's fever only when the parent arrived to the program to pick up said child. Program was not in compliance with this regulation.


