<p>Failed to maintain proper staff/child ratios outside on the playground when a staff person left a group of children outside with two teachers and 21 children. Staff did not adhere to the appropriate staff/child ratio of 10:1. Staff also did not adhere to the program's supervision policy when staff did not maintain proper ratios and did not count children before transition. Program was not in compliance with this regulation.</p>		
VIOLATION	Statute - 19a-79-4a(c)(4)(D) Regulation	Description: 021b-Supervision
<p>Failed to ensure the supervision of children at all times while outdoors when a child- who was jumping on equipment on the playground, fell off of the equipment landed on his face. Child sustained injuries to his face. OEC reviewed video footage and observed two staff on the opposite side of the playground with their backs to the said child (as well as at least 4 other children). Staff did not adhere to the program's supervision policy when they did not strategically position themselves to be near high risk areas.</p>
