


All of the children were put in their own individual cots to rest. During the walk through, the bathroom sink was left unlocked and it was discussed to remember to lock it to keep personal items inaccessible. Provider repainted the home and license was not posted. She posted it during the visit. Provider has submitted an application for an assistant with the OEC and it is pending in our system. It was discussed that an assistant may only work once they gave their approval and they may never be left alone with the children.
