VIOLATION	Statute - Regulation [19a-79-3a(b)(8)(C)]	Description: 003c-Child Protection
<p>Staff were neglectful when child was left unattended in an unsupervised outdoor area that is adjacent to the busy street and parking lot. It is not sure how the child got from one fenced area to another as staff state that a gate between the two areas was closed. A narrow space between a gate and fence is the only other way the child could've made it to the infant play yard where found.</p>		
VIOLATION	Statute - Regulation [19a-79-3a(d)(2) thru (8) &/or 19a-79-7a(d)(11)(A)]	Description: 006-Policies
<p>Failed to implement policies, plans and procedures when staff failed to follow the policy of counting children at all thresholds and notating the times. Staff had completed a form with numbers of children in advance of time, not ensuring that children were all accounted for. Failed to follow program policy of reporting incidents to families no matter how minor. Parents need to be notified of all incidents related to their child regardless of amount of time left unattended or that child was not harmed.</p>		
VIOLATION	Statute - Regulation 19a-79-4a(c)(4)(D)	Description: 021a-Supervision
<p>Failed to ensure the supervision of children at all times while outdoors when a two year old child was left outdoors after his class went back inside. Child was unattended for approximately 11 1/2 minutes based on review of camera in the classroom.</p>


