

Discussed with provider the following;

- Provider understands her background check expires February 26, 2025. Licensing specialist provided provider link to get into BCIS with steps to renew her background check.
- Provider explained to licensing specialist safe sleep requirements/regulations. She shared with licensing specialist a new infant has enrolled in program as of 10/21/24. All of new infant's enrollment documents are current and complete on file on site.
- Provider demonstrated a crib in basement to licensing specialist and wanted to confirm if it is acceptable to use in daycare. Sticker of manufacturer date was ripped off. Licensing specialist emailed Delta Children's crib company with crib model number to confirm manufacturer date. Provider understands she may not use crib in daycare until company responds with manufacturer date.
- Ensuring provider practices and documents emergency drills four times a year. Observed last emergency drill documented 5/21/24.
- Emphasized importance of ensuring there are no hazards around children when they are present in daycare.
- Emphasized importance of engaging children in various activities including daily outdoor play weather permitting.
