#4 Capacity Continued..
 Upon arrival when licensing specialist began inspection and asked the substitute how many children were present she stated 6. However, when licensing specialist counted the children there were 7 present (provider's child was sleeping in crib). Substitute apologized she did not realize she was there due to the substitute arriving later in the morning. Licensing specialist reminded substitute it is very important to take into account how many children are present in one's care. Approximately 7 minutes later the provider arrived to childcare with two children in her care creating a total of 9 children. During that same transition, a substitute/parent came and picked up one of the children making a total of 8 children as of 9:45am.
 Per provider, the substitute/parent that picked up the child is a child not listed on previous enrollment form from previous inspection. Child is a drop in, has all enrollment documents except written permissions document.
 Discussed with provider importance of always maintaining compliance when it comes to capacity and also communicating with substitute on how many children are present before leaving substitute with children.
 Discussed with provider importance of always ensuring all conditions on consent order are in compliance.
 Discussed with provider importance of supervising what children are watching on television, observed two older children watching youtube on television during inspection.
 Did not observe any infants enrolled in childcare or infants sleeping during inspection.
