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DISCUSSIONS/COMMENTS

Discussed with provider the following-

- Importance of maintaining compliance with safe sleep regulations at all times and ensuring all infants under 12 months old are placed to sleep in a crib or pack n play or equipment specifically designed for sleeping.
- Importance of infants sleeping without blankets.
- Ensuring cribs in childcare have a tight fitted sheet. Observed a crib with a blanket wrapped around the mattress as a sheet. No child was sleeping inside of crib.
- Importance of ensuring all children enrolled must have all enrollment documents complete and available upon enrollment in childcare.
- Importance of ensuring all children are supervised at all times, if provider needs to rest for a moment she may utilize an approved substitute to take her place.

- *It is the provider's responsibility to ensure compliance with all local codes and/or ordinances applicable to single and multi-family dwellings. This includes but is not limited to renovation, construction or expansion of the facility as well as the installation of a swimming pool or auxiliary heater.*
