<p>Program not in compliance with maintaining a written feeding schedule for infants when 2 infants enrolled do not have a written feeding schedule. Two feeding schedules were not followed when; a bottle was heated in a microwave, and when a infant was being fed in a manner that was not specified on the feeding schedule. The 3 feeding schedules that are on site for infants indicate that the bottles should be warmed via hot water.</p>		


