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Program not in compliance with maintaining the interior, exterior and grounds of the building in a clean and orderly manner when mouse feces was observed in multiple areas of the building - in cabinets in the infant room, in closet where snacks are stored, on the floor in the toddler room, and on top of the preschool 2 cubbies in the kitchen area. Program not in compliance with maintaining the building, equipment and services in a good state of repair when there is a large hole in the wall under the sink in the infant room.

Statute and/or Regulation and Description:	[19a-79-7a(e)(16)]	100- Prevention of vermin- openings screened
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Program not in compliance with ensuring effective measures have been taken to prevent vermin from entering or breeding in the facility when mouse feces was observed in multiple areas of the center and when a staff observed a mouse in the toddler room on 12/17/25 in the morning. Staff also reported seeing a squirrel in the building and traps have not yet been set in the attic where professionals determined they were coming in.
