Upon arrival at 2:35pm, the specialist was greeted at the door by DCFS.93001. The substitute was alone caring for 7 children, including 1 infant. The specialist observed a 6-month-old infant asleep in a bassinet with a stuffed animal, a rattle toy, and a teething ring. The specialist told the substitute that infants 12 months and younger must sleep in a safe crib, play pen, or other equipment designed for infant sleep free from hazards. The items were immediately removed from the bassinet. The specialist asked DCFS.93001 where the provider was. DCFS.93001 replied that the provider left the home 15 minutes prior to the specialist's arrival to go to a doctor's appointment and would return in 5 minutes. The provider returned to the home at 2:54pm. The specialist informed the provider that she left the substitute over capacity which is a violation of OEC statutes and regulations. The specialist reviewed safe sleep and capacity regulations with the provider.

- It is the provider's responsibility to ensure compliance with all local codes and/or ordinances applicable to single and multi-family dwellings. This includes but is not limited to renovation, construction or expansion of the facility as well as the installation of a swimming pool or auxiliary heater.
