#36 Continuation _ Provider had some difficulties trying to remove the fire extinguisher from the support piece. A small amount of the dry powder was discharged, which the provider cleaned up. Fire extinguisher was located upstairs in the kitchen, the main child care area is in the basement . Children come upstairs for pick-up time, waiting in a room. _Reviewed requirements for influenza vaccine, no religious exemption since 4/28/21 in Connecticut, certificate for medical exemption for vaccines (DPH Vaccine Exemption Certificate), flu vaccine season yearly from January 1st to March 31. __Discussed posting new license upon renewal. Communication will be send by e-mail inviting to renew.
